- Supervises and manages nursing activities. Supervises nursing staff and evaluates clinical practice. Provides adequate staffing and supervision. Participates in and contributes to staff development programs.
- Involves the patient, family, and community in setting realistic goals to achieve desired outcomes.

KNOWLEDGE: Knowledge of principles and practices of nursing is mandatory.
