# What Does the New Mission Mean for the 107th?

- We're taking a proactive approach in this conversion to help you achieve your full potential within the Wing's future.
- There will be many opportunities throughout the Wing to include new AFSCs both part-time and full-time.
- It's important for you to know where you stand and what you need to do to achieve your goals.

# I am Traditional (part time) and Wish to Stay Traditional

- If your job is affected by the conversion, please ensure you make a reclassification appointment to get the process started and propose a new position
- If your job is not affected and are interested in any of the new positions, please make a reclassification appointment to see if you are eligible to cross train
  - 3 year rule
  - Bonus ramifications

# I am Traditional but I want a Full Time Opportunity

- When the new Full Time Jobs are posted, apply for each one you qualify for.
  - Look at prerequisites on job posting for:
    - Area of Consideration ( Status requirement )
    - AFSC Requirement
    - Authorized Grade (Rank requirement)
    - Educational requirement
  - Must have passing PT score

# I Am Full-Time and Want to Stay Full-Time

- Full-Time positions will be out for bid once we receive the notification for implementation of the new UMD.
- We recommend that you apply for everything that you qualify for.
- Many of the new Full-Time positions will be AGR.

# I am Full Time But I Want to Become a Traditional Guardsman

- If you decide that you would like to go the traditional guardsman route, we have options for you too.
- Schedule an appointment with the retention office to discuss your options.

- **ASVAB Scores** (emailed on Career Change Worksheet)
- **Current & Passing PT Test** (Provided at appointment)
- **Physical Profile** (provided at appointment from clinic)
- **Commanders approval** (Career Change Worksheet)

# How the Process Works

- 1) Schedule Re-class appointment on SharePoint
- 2) Career Change Worksheet is forwarded via email for CC signature
- 3) Bring signed Career Change Worksheet to appointment (Retention Office)
- 4) Retention will issue Medical Profile & PT scores, take copy of Driver's License
- 5) Go to Recruiting Office for Re-class briefing to discuss options & answer questions
- 6) Meet with CMSgt Henning in Rm. 229 or CMSgt Wohleben to address any further questions/concerns (i.e.: fulltime questions)

# What if My ASVAB Scores are too low?

- AFCT is the testing method for current unit members
- You can retest the AFCT every Tuesday at 0800, contact your UTM to schedule through base training
- New scores will be score of record
- You need to wait 6 months to retest again if required

- If you received a bonus, you will not be losing it in the conversion as long as you remain in your AFSC until your current position is removed from the manning document and you are placed into a new AFSC.
- **No moves will be made** until guidance is given to place people on new manning document, time TBA.
